There will be no drilling or intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO DOUBLE HANDLING will be permitted at this show. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.

There is no space provided for unentered dogs. Puppies and dogs not entered in this show are not permitted on the show grounds.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.

The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be picked up at the show, none will be mailed.

All awards will be made in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the rightful winner of the award.

NOTE: 1st Place winners of Veteran Dog / Veteran Bitch Classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed **IF** undefeated in any other class at this show.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

See current edition of the *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* or contact the Show Secretary for Best of Breed Entry Requirements; Move-Up Procedures, etc.

AWARD(S) OF MERIT

The judge may, at his / her discretion, award **UP TO FIVE AWARD OF MERIT** Rosettes

NON-REGULAR CLASSES Multiple Dog Entries

STUD DOG CLASS for stud dogs and at least two, but not more than three, of their get Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the stud dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. Judging to be on the merits of the get. Get must be entered in another class in this show.

BROOD BITCH CLASS

same as for the stud dog except substitute brood bitch for stud dog and produce for get.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males **may be entered** as Stud Dog and spayed females **may be entered** as Brood Bitch.

BRACE CLASS Fee is \$26.00 as a unit

Effective 1/1/05 – **Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers.**

Both dogs in the Brace must have at least one common owner.

- Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry.
- Both dogs in the Brace **MUST BE ENTERED** in another class at this show with the appropriate individual Entry Fee plus "Brace As A Unit" Fee.
- Brace must be marked as an "Additional Class" on the Official AKC Entry Form. If more than one Brace is entered by an individual owner, please designate dogs comprising each Brace as "Brace # 1", "Brace # 2", etc.

NOTE: As the judges decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes is based upon the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won in these classes.

1st Place Winners of the Junior Sweepstakes Classes will compete for **Best Junior in Puppy Sweepstakes** and **Best of Opposite Sex to Best Junior**.

1st Place Winners of the Senior Sweepstakes Classes will compete for **Best Senior in Puppy Sweepstakes** and **Best of Opposite Sex to Best Senior**.

There will be no competition between the Best Junior & Best Senior Winners.

Puppy Sweepstakes classes will be judged prior to the regular classes.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have not won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS for boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have not won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have not won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS for boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS for boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show; who at the time entries close **have won 3 First Place awards**, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

The winner of a third first place in each Novice Class shall automatically become eligible to enter the corresponding Open Class at the show, provided the win is the third first place with competition and further provided there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in that Open Class.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered and shown in one of the breed or obedience classes at the show, or must be entered for JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ONLY. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season, or a veterinarian's excuse, may be replaced by another dog meeting the below ownership requirements. Such substitution must be requested in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an Official AKC Entry Form. All such requests must be made one-half hour prior to the judging of any Regular Classes at the show.

Each dog must be owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations, or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. **Bitches in season are not eligible. At a Specialty Show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.**

A dog that has been rejected, dismissed or excused by a veterinarian for the protection of other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship. Entries for regular Junior Showmanship Classes shall close at the same time that entries close for this show.

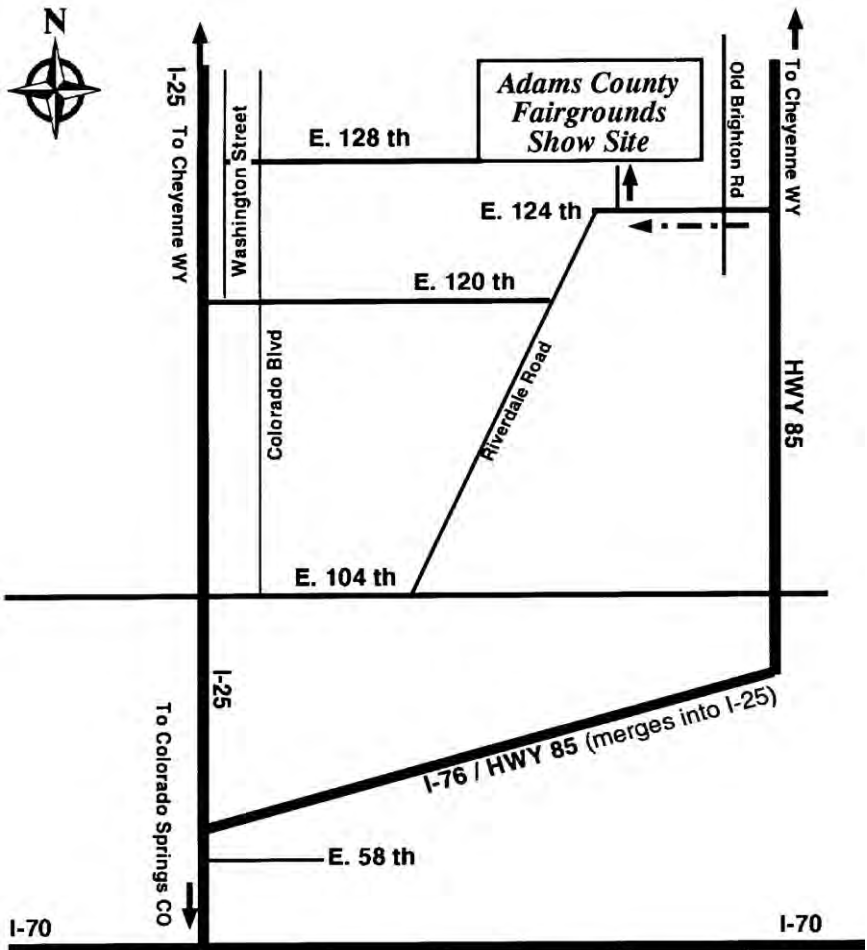
